Accessibility Highlight Video: Navigation Menu

Visual description: This video shows the navigation menu for the "Identity and Representation" webtext. The narrator tabs through the menu options while describing how a thin blue outline or "focus ring" indicates which option has been selected by the reader.

Transcript: This video is all about menu navigation. My main goals when designing the navigation menu were to make the menu options as simple as possible to read and select. I adjusted color contrast and font to make each menu choice stand out more clearly and made choices in my CSS that enable "focus." By focus, what I mean is that when I tab through the options in this menu, each menu item is outlined in blue for visibility. Options are similarly outlined when I hover over them with a mouse. When selected, an item in the menu assumes a different background color and font to help readers visually orient themselves in the webtext. To further aid in orienting the reader, active pages do not have links that can be selected as these would merely lead back to the same page.
