Accessibility Highlight Video: Page Width

Visual description: This video shows a page in the "Identity and Representation" webtext. The narrator demonstrates zooming in and out on the text while discussing page-width settings.

Transcript: This video discusses page width. I've made sizing choices in this webtext with the assumption that some readers may need to zoom in or out, or may be viewing this text on a mobile device. Because I don't know what sizing my readers may need, I've chosen not to use a set width for any of my pages. Instead, pages can be resized to fit whichever device a person might be using to read. Try hitting Ctrl+ on a PC or COMMAND+ on a Mac to see the results in practice. Notice that it's possible to zoom in and out without having words run off the page. This would not be possible if we were using a fixed width for each of the pages.
