Transcript: In this video I'll briefly discuss tables and accessibility. When it comes to tables, I've chosen to make my data as "readable" as possible for screen readers. By this I mean that I've tagged each cell in such a way that an assistive device will recognize the contents as data to be read out. I've also captioned each table to provide general context for someone who cannot take in the dataset visually as a whole.
